

Description of the Bursary

The "Fernand Lindsay Career Bursary" offers a young, highly talented and strongly motivated musician a springboard to an international career. This bursary provides the musician with the financial resources needed to acquire the skills, timely advice, and opportunities to achieve this goal.

- Best project: one \$50,000 bursary, including \$10,000 presented when the winner is announced on October 1, 2019. The remainder (\$40,000) will be paid out over the following three or four years, as needed, to cover project-related expenses, which must be pre-approved by the Père Lindsay Foundation.
- Second and third finalists: two \$5,000 bursaries, presented on October 1, 2019 in recognition of the quality of their applications.
- All three winners will be able to register, free of charge, for the career management seminars organized by the Père Lindsay Foundation.

Eligible candidates

- Musicians 30 years of age or under on September 30, 2019
- Singers and conductors 33 years of age or under on September 30, 2019
- Canadian citizens residing in Québec for at least 5 years (Quebecers studying abroad are eligible)
- Up-and-coming artists targeting an international career

Duly completed and signed documents to be submitted with the application form

Letter of interest from the mentor

2 reference letters

Current curriculum vitae (maximum 3 pages)

Copy of a photo ID

□ Non-refundable \$300 cheque

The mentor is selected by the candidate to provide quality support and help ensure the success of the project throughout the entire period covered by the bursary.

The CV must present the applicant's past experience, training, internships and achievements as a musician. (The repertoire is not required).

Reference letters must support the aspects highlighted in the CV.

Incomplete, incorrectly addressed or ineligible applications will be automatically rejected and the enclosed cheque will be returned without notice by the secretariat of the Fernand Lindsay Career Bursary.
