

Fernand Lindsay Career Bursary 2024 Competition Application Form

Description of the Bursary

The "Fernand Lindsay Career Bursary" offers a young, highly talented and strongly motivated musician a springboard to an international career. This bursary provides the musician with the financial resources needed to acquire the skills, timely advice, and opportunities to achieve this goal.

- Best project: one \$50,000 bursary, including \$10,000 presented when the winner is announced in the fall, 2022. The remainder (\$40,000) will be paid out over the following three or four years, as needed, to cover project-related expenses, which must be pre-approved by the Père Lindsay Foundation.
- Second and third finalists: \$15,000 and \$10,000 bursaries, presented in the fall, 2024 in recognition of the quality of their applications.
- All three winners will be able to register, free of charge, for the career management seminars organized by the Père Lindsay Foundation.

Eligible candidates

- Musicians 30 years of age or under on June 30, 2024
- Singers and conductors 33 years of age or under on June 30, 2024
- Canadian citizens residing in Qu!bec for at least 5 years (Quebecers studying abroad are éligible)
- Up-and-coming artists targeting an international career
